

E.C.S. Technologies Inc.**Terms and Conditions**

Program Co-Ordinator refers to E.C.S. Technologies Inc.

Approved Wastes include Biomedical Waste and/or Pharmaceutical Waste containing in its entirety of sharps, pharmaceuticals, and biomedical cleanup according to waste pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Environmental Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990. Additional wastes include amalgam and lead foil.

Exclusions pertain to all anatomical waste, toxic waste, sewage waste and any waste liquid or solid not outlined under the Approved Wastes.

Appropriate Packaging will be supplied to the customer as part of the program. It will be the customers responsibility to package all contents as per the shipping and preparation documents.

Appropriate Waste Disposal will be arranged by E.C.S. Technologies Inc. and will be in compliance as outlined in Ontario Regulation 347.

1. **Program Outline.** The Program Co-Ordinator will provide the appropriate packaging materials for shipping of the Approved Wastes as outlined in the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act and the Ministry of Transportation. Shipping documents and preparations are provided with additional on-line support available. All supplied storage and/or collection containers are to be fully assembled prior to use and are compliant with Ontario Regulation 347, Ontario Environmental Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990 and with TDGA.
2. **Customers Commitment.** The customer shall agree to collect only the Approved Wastes in the containers and packaging provided and will package and prepare all contents as set forth in the shipping documents and packaging procedures. The customer will submit a packaging confirmation document to E.C.S. prior to every shipment. The customer has the right to request additional material and will have access to on-line support and documents.
3. **Transportation.** Any packaging that does not follow the Appropriate Packaging guidelines may be refused by the MOEE approved personnel sanctioned by the Program Co-Ordinator.
4. **Penalties and Surcharge.** E.C.S. will impose a surcharge of \$55.00 in the event the Appropriate Packaging requirements were not followed resulting in a refusal of pick up or in the event the package was not ready or the location was closed following a pick up request. If the packaging weight exceeds the generous weights outlined under the Approved Packaging, the package may be refused or when possible required to be separated into additional packaging (additional disposal fees will be applied). In the event the Approved Wastes are not followed, termination of further business may be imminent as well as a \$500.00 breach in agreement.
5. **Payment and Charges.** The Program Co-Ordinator will provide pricing prior to containers or other services being performed. In the event the customer has been delinquent, payment in advance will be required. There will be No hidden charges that are not outlined in the Terms and Conditions.
6. **Contract.** Unless requested by the customer, there is no contract.
7. **Financial Terms.** The Program Co-Ordinator will provide a single invoice which includes but not limited to: supply of containers, packaging and transportation and disposal of approved wastes. Payment will be made through credit card, or through invoice with 30 days to pay. Late charges may be applied and specified on the invoice.
8. **Force Majeure.** Neither party shall be liable for its failure or delay to perform in whole or in part due to contingencies beyond its reasonable control including but not limited to: acts of God, strikes, war, fire, etc. The obligation to pay for services rendered will still be required.
9. **Entire Agreement.** This agreement (including all attachments, appropriate packaging and other guidelines made available to the customer), constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and cancels all prior understandings and agreements, either written or oral with respect to the subject matter hereof.
10. **Terms.** The Terms and Conditions will be required prior to the first pick up taking place at each location. This agreement will be received in advance by fax or through our on-line services. This acknowledgment confirms that you have read and understood all the requirements set forth and agree that you will comply to the Approved Wastes, Approved Packaging and the Penalties and Surcharges that may apply if not followed.

- I have ensured all containers are tightly sealed / locked and have placed them into the yellow bag.
- I verify that ABSOLUTELY ALL SHARPS in inside of the sealed sharps containers and there are NO sharps loosely placed into the box.
- I have tightly tied the yellow bag closed.
- I have sealed the shipping box with shipping tape and am confident it can not break
- I have placed all shipping labels on the box.

NOTE: only the following items can be placed into a Sharps Container. These items include sharps including needles, needles attached to syringes, metal cutting instruments, pins, cutting blades and broken glass capable of causing punctures or cuts. All other waste streams require other approved and appropriate containers.
